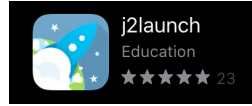
How to access my child's J2E Learning Space For Distance Learning



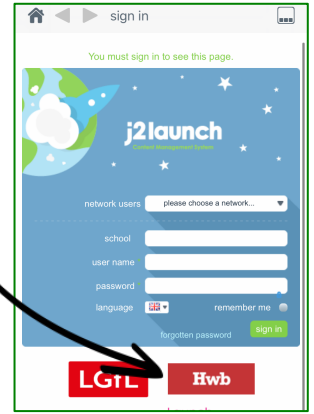
Step 1

Downloading the Software

The J2E platform can be accessed through a web browser, however there is an app available for any Apple device. If using the app to access work, pupils must click on 'Hwb' located on the home screen and sign in using their Hwb account details.



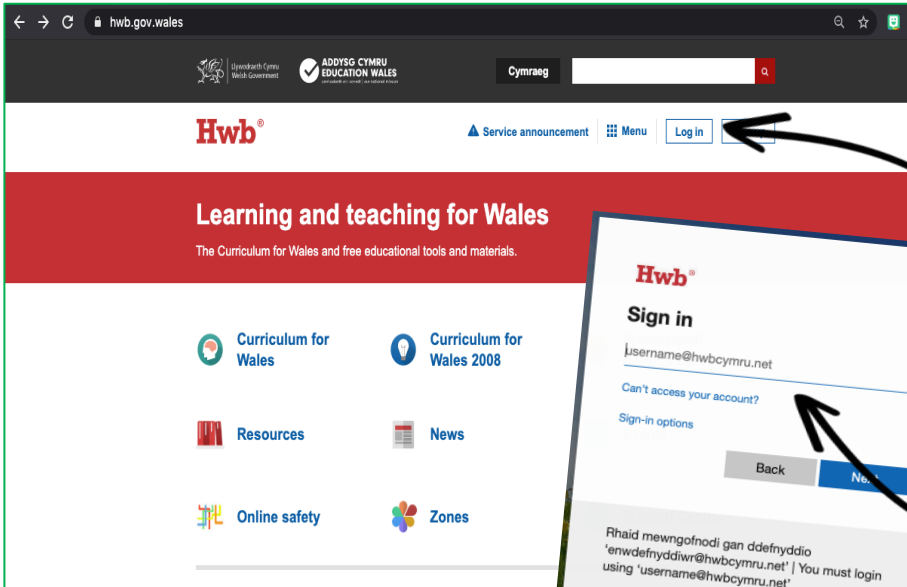
J2E Launch App

Sign into Hwb learning Platform

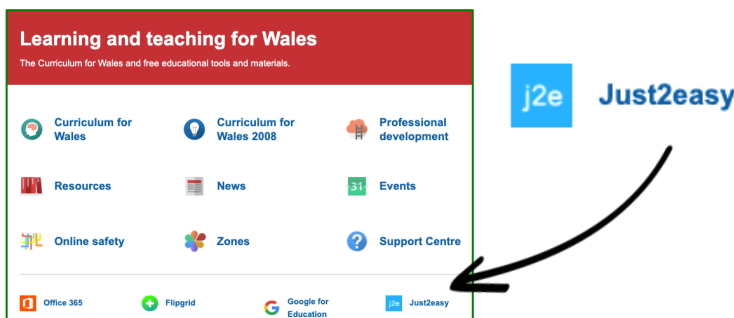
If you are not using the J2E app, use a web browser to access Hwb. If you are unsure of your child's Hwb details, please contact the school or support section of our school website.



Sign into Hwb by visiting: **HWB.GOV.WALES**
Remember passwords are **CASE SENSITIVE** and always include a capital letter at the start and a number

Locate J2E on the Hwb dashboard



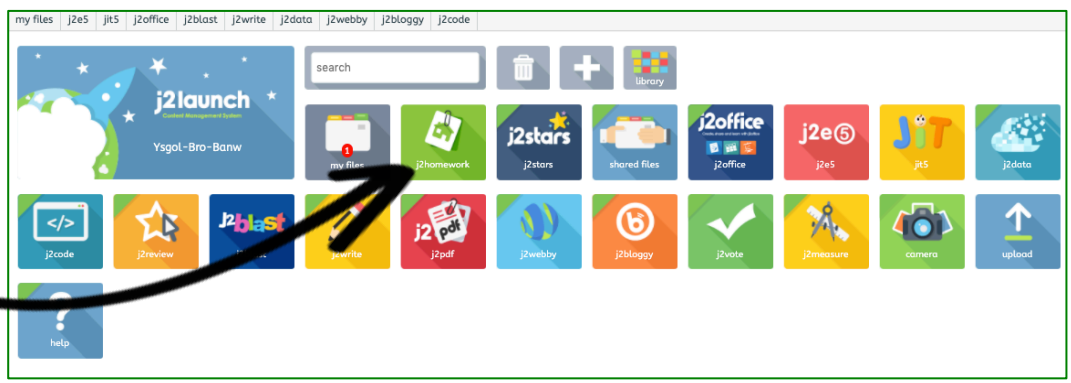
The J2E icon will only show on the Hwb homepage when a pupil is signed in

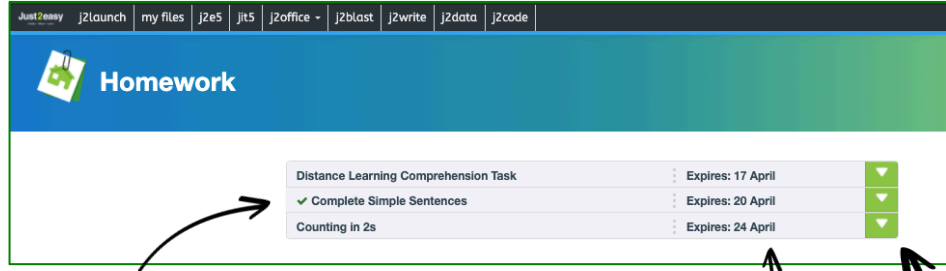


(J2Launch Pad)

Any tasks set for your child will be displayed on the Homework page.

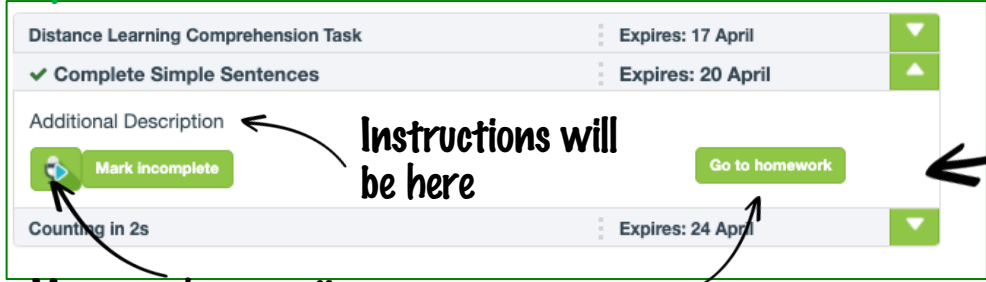

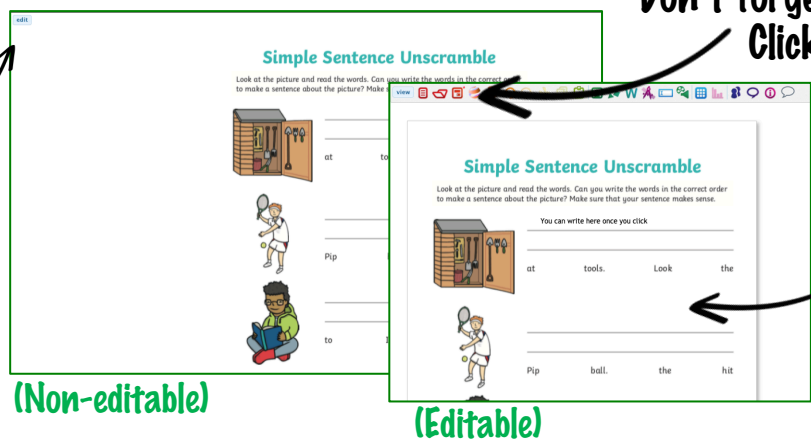
