Office staff, on request, can also provide you with a holiday form, breakfast club form or a 'medication' form. The medication form only needs to be completed if your child is taking prescribed medication three-four times a day such as antibiotics, allergy or asthma pumps. If your child is, please hand this paperwork into a member of staff from your child's class with medication labelled (from a chemist). Please note, no medication can be given unless prescribed by a GP or a form completed by parents/ guardians.

If your child is ill, please inform the school office by 9:30am. You can leave a message if the line is busy.



To the parents/carers of all **current Year 6 pupils**, you are required to submit an admission application for a Year 7 place at Cynffig or another comprehensive for September 2026 for your child/ren.

For children born between 1 September 2014 and 31 August 2015, who will be starting a Year 7 class in September 2026, the admission round is as follows:

Action	Date
Opening date for submission of applications	10am on Monday, 13 October 2025
Closing date for receipt of applications by the local authority	4pm on Friday, 16 January 2026

A Y7 place application **must be submitted** to secure your child's place. There is no automatic admission to a comprehensive school.



To the parents/carers of all **current full-time Nursery pupils**, you are required to submit an admission application for a Reception place at Afon Y Felin Primary school for September 2026 for your child/ren.

For children born between 1 September 2021 and 31 August 2022, who will be starting a Reception class in September 2026, the admission round is as follows:

Action	Date
Opening date for submission of applications	10am on Monday, 10 November 2025
Closing date for receipt of applications by the local authority	4pm on Friday, 13 February 2026

A Reception place application **must be submitted** to secure your child's place. There is no automatic admission to our infant school, regardless of the school that a child currently attends as a Full-time Nursery pupil.



To the parents/carers of children **currently in part-time Nursery provision** and requiring a full-time Nursery place for September 2026, you are required to submit an admission application for a Nursery place at Afon Y Felin Primary school for September 2026 for your child/ren.

For children born between 1 September 2022 and 31 August 2023, who will be starting full-time Nursery in September 2026, the admission round is as follows:

Action	Date
Applications open	10am on Monday 5 January 2026
Closing date for receipt of applications by the local authority	4pm on Friday 3 April 2026

A Nursery place application **must be submitted** to secure your child's place. There is no automatic admission to our primary school, regardless of the school that a child currently attends as a part-time Nursery pupil.
